

JOHN LEHMANN-HAUPT, "UNSUNG GUITAR." John Lehmann-Haupt's aptitude on steel-string acoustic is beautifully displayed on this disc, not as a type of spectacle to awe the listener, but rather as a vehicle to conduct a dozen nicely melodic tunes. And that he does admirably. All but a few songs on the record are played in solo style (only drums and bass guitar appear on the exceptions). His covers of the Rolling Stones' hit, "Let's Spend The Night Together," and James Taylor's "Fire And Rain" are embellished with a number of chord melody techniques and a broad range of dynamics that make the songs toe-tapping, hum-along material without making them sound like humdrum rehashes.
